As you may recall, in February 2015, a number of Everest campuses and Everest University Online were purchased by Zenith Education Group (Zenith), a nonprofit provider of career education. Since that time, we have focused on upgrading our programming, reducing the cost of education, and increasing resources available to students.

As part of this transformation effort, the decision was made to change the name of Everest to **Altierus Career College** in the states of CO, FL, GA, NV, OH, OR, TX, VA, and WA and change the name to **Altierus Career Education** in the state of MI, effective August 8, 2017. *The name change applies only to campuses and online programs that remain active and fully operational in these states.*

If the campus or program from which you graduated received the name change to Altierus, your transcripts will reflect the new name. If you graduated from a campus or program that did not receive the name change, your transcripts will reflect the Everest name.
