Accreditation:

Kaplan University is accredited by The Higher Learning Commission (HLC). In addition, some programs are accredited by their individual accrediting agencies. Kaplan University's main campus is in Davenport, IA, and this location should be referenced in confirming accreditation.

Augusta and Lewiston, Maine, campuses have a multiple-campus CAAHEP accreditation for the Medical Assistant Certificate program and for MAERB reporting purposes identify the Lewiston campus, 475 Lisbon Street, Lewiston, ME 04240, as the main campus. Similar arrangements are made with the Lincoln and Omaha, Nebraska campuses that identify the Lincoln campus, 1821 K Street, Lincoln, NE 68508, as the main campus.

Concord Law School is registered with the State Bar of California as an unaccredited law school with its primary administrative office in Los Angeles, CA.

Additional programmatic and school accreditations and approvals can be found in the University Catalog.

Campuses:

Kaplan University is comprised of the KU-Online campus, which includes Open College students; the KU-Ground campuses located in Indiana, Iowa, Maine, Maryland, Missouri, Nebraska, and Wisconsin; and Concord Law located in California. All locations share courses and curriculum. References in this document to "KU campuses" refers to both KU-Online and KU-Ground campuses. The enrollment summary at the end of the transcript indicates which campus(es) the student attended.

Credit System:

KU campuses are on the quarter system. Concord Law is on the semester system. KU courses taken while enrolled at Concord Law are expressed as semester credits. Concord Law students complete 45 hours of preparation and study per semester course credit.

Some campuses converted systems in the past—refer to the Transcript Key Supplement for students enrolled at the Maine campuses prior to 2010 or at the Maryland campus prior to 2002.

Calendar System:

KU campuses and Concord Law are year-round. For California state bar purposes, the administrative years for Concord Law are the following: Winter cohort (January 1 - December 31), Spring cohort (April 1 - March 31), Summer cohort (June 28 - June 27), and Fall cohort (August 15 - August 14).

Grade Point Average (GPA):

A student's GPA is calculated by dividing the sum of the earned quality points by the sum of the attempted credits for all courses receiving a grade used in calculating the GPA. Only work completed at Kaplan University is used in GPA calculations.

While enrolled at a KU campus, the grade received on the last repeat of a course becomes the final grade and will replace all other grades for that course in GPA calculations. While enrolled at Concord Law, all grades received are used in GPA calculations. When a student changes program of study, only the courses applicable to the new program are included in the GPA calculations for that program.

Withdrawal, prior learning, pass, and incomplete grades generally do not affect the GPA. Current grade definitions can be found in the University Catalog

Disqualified Credits:

Concord Law students in the Juris Doctor program must complete a minimum number of credits/hours of qualifying law study to be certified to take the California Bar Exam. Students who do not complete the minimum requirements may have their credits disqualified. Prior to terms starting April 2017, Juris Doctor students who received insufficient passing grades may have half of the course credits disqualified. Disqualified credits of law study are notated with a [DQ] in the grade.
