My name is Anne Golden and I am a recent graduate of Drexel University's Master of Public Health program. While searching for career opportunities I came across Cora Services Incorporated and I am very interested in the Prevention Education Specialist position.

Before beginning the Master of Public Health program at Drexel University I attended the Pennsylvania State University and earned a Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Biobehavioral Health. During my time as an undergraduate student I was able to engage in volunteer, academic, and employment opportunities that led me to discover the field of public health. These opportunities included volunteering as a health literacy tutor, taking courses in health promotion, and working as a job coach.

In March of 2019 I earned a Master of Public Health degree with a major in Community Health and Prevention and a minor in Program Monitoring and Evaluation. My role as a Food Access Fellow included supporting weekly meal services at Old Pine Community Center, managing the monthly and master reporting for the Meals and More program, producing grant proposals, creating seasonal healthy meal flyers, and engaging in meaningful conversations with stakeholders to gauge capacity among partner meal providers at the Hub of Hope. I then developed a capacity building toolkit for current and future partner meal providers.
